FLY LIL DEVIL dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, shook loose at the eighth pole and was clear late and held sway. RAZADDAX dueled from the outside early, battled with the winner through the drive but could not match strides through the stretch. BUZZ ON THE MOUNT outrun early, advanced inside entering the turn, altered outside for the drive and closed with a rush. T HALL forced the early pace from the inside, held a forward position but had nothing left. BUG MAN was no real factor. KELAMON was no threat. CHOSIN FEW chased the early pace from the outside and tired. JOHN ETBAUER faded. BUCKLE DOWN was never close.
