LADY O' WAR dueled from the outside early, remained engaged up the backstretch, battled with HIGHHOPESDANCER through the drive and inched clear of that one late. HIGHHOPESDANCER dueled from the inside early, battled up the backstretch, remained engaged with the winner but could not match strides. CARENCRO chased the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, responded but could only gain the show. IT'S A ECHO RUMOR outrun early, could only improve position. BARZAK forced the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn but had nothing left and bled. THAT SILVER was no factor. LEALLAH ANNIE had a steady fade.
