Footnotes

HOSS broke sharp from between foes to gain a clear early margin, dueled up the backstretch with RUSHMORE, put that one away entering the second turn, opened a clear margin at the eighth pole and held sway. BUSTED ACCOUNT stalked the early pace from the inside, crept closer entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive, responded and was getting to the winner. GUILTY PLEA well placed from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, responded and finished well. RUSHMORE broke well from the outside, rushed up to duel up the backstretch, remained forward but had no late response. JORDON BE FAST could only pass tired ones. SAM THE SHIFTER could only improve position. RAISING THE KAPP was no factor. POSSE COMITATUS was no threat. MORENO SKY had a steady fade. EL TORO ROJO forced the early pace outside and tired.
