Footnotes

CADDO NATIVE stalked the early pace from the outside, crept closer entering the second turn, responded to pressure to duel with COTILE LAKE through the drive and inched clear of that one late. COTILE LAKE dueled from the outside early, battled up the backstretch with SKIP THRU TIME, put that one away entering the second turn, was engaged by the winner entering the drive, dueled with that one through the stretch but could not match strides. MIRACLE CREEK outrun early, steadily advanced outside up the backstretch, responded entering the second turn, was carried six wide into the drive and was gaining late. BEAUDUSA broke through the gate prior to the start, was crowded at the start, pressed the early pace from the inside, remained forward for the drive but had nothing left. ARTIC SEA broke in at the start, chased the early pace from the outside but had no late response. KOHNKE HILL ROAD was no factor. T ERL had little impact. SKIP THRU TIME dueled from the inside and gave way.
