RAILROAD SHOW stalked the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the second turn, made a bid to gain a short advantage and outfinished rivals the final yards. BANDIT'S BOOTY chased the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive but could not reach the winner. BUTTER BROWN well placed from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn, made a bid along the rail and finished well. FOUR BY FOUR broke sharp from the inside, gained a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, showed the way entering the second turn the tired in the drive. DA WHEELER could only pass tired ones. MUSICMEISTER could only improve position. IDE WHISTLE DIXIE was no factor. APACHE N CO. was no threat. SADIE'S DEELITES forced the early pace and gave way. CUZ JOLEE had a steady fade.
