### Footnotes

LITE THE CIGAR unhurried early, advanced outside up the backstretch, made a bid entering the second turn, gained the advantage mid stretch and steadily drew clear. A GOOD DAY TO FLY dueled from the inside for the early lead, gained a clear margin entering the backstretch, remained clear entering the second turn, held a forward position at the eighth pole but was no match late while holding position. LATCH LIGHTING well placed from the inside early, advanced up the backstretch, altered outside for the drive but could not keep pace. K OTEE outrun early, made a bid entering the second turn but could only improve position. GONE LA. pressed the early pace from the outside but had nothing left for the drive. MARION PONDEROSA chased the early pace outside but had no late response. LEAVING TULSA was no factor. POLITICAL ROCK dueled from the outside, prompted the pace up the backstretch then tired. LOGAN'S PRIZE forced the early pace outside and tired. HIGH HOPES MALIBU was finished early.
