OUR SMITTY broke a step slow then moved to within striking distance while steadily advance and closed willingly when asked. CHEROKEE HIGH was bumped at the start then vied for the lead on the back stretch then drifted in on MY CHARLIE RAY on the turn but held on for the show. DON'T RUSH ME was in tight after the break was never far back improved position on the turn before drifting in on CAJUN SENSATION in the stretch drive. SHYLOH'S FRIEND was squeezed back after the break and steadied, made a move three wide on the turn but had nothing left for the drive. LEAD THE TROOPS broke in and bumped MY CHARLIE RAY at the break and was never a factor. BEXAR INTREST broke in slightly then raced in the middle of the pack before giving way in the turn. CAJUN SENSATION broke out and bumped CHEROKEE HIGH vied for the lead and was steadied when CHEROKEE HIGH drifted in on the turn straightened out then was in tight in the stretch and steadied again.
