Footnotes

SAYONARAY'ALL was unhurried in the early stages while saving ground through the backstretch then angled out four wide in the turn and finished strong on the outside. WHISTLING BRAHMS was rushed to the lead while dueling two wide throughout and was outfinished. BOSS LADY MARY rushed to contention going into the first turn, dueled with leader through the middle of the stretch drive but didn't respond late. TERRIFIC INDY stalked the pace throughout while race two wide and lacked a late response. FOREST PEGASUS broke in slightly was forwardly placed but raced evenly. BRILLIANT STORM was fractious in the gate, trailed early and improved position late. GO FOR GALE was not a threat. HALILUKE vied for the lead on the inside then dropped back on the backstretch and weakened. KEECHIE NIGHT showed little. LARK STONE broke out slightly and was never a factor.
