TWILIGHT ROSS bumped entering the first turn when BOWLING drifted out, recovered to stalk the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn, gained the margin at the eighth pole, opened a clear advantage deep stretch then held sway. ONEAFTERNOON well placed from the outside, advanced entering the second turn, responded and was getting to the winner. QUAZAR broke sharp from the outside, gained a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, remained forward for the drive but could not keep pace. DYNAPAC far back early, advanced outside, responded and had good energy late. BOWLING drifted out entering the first turn bothering rivals and was no factor. After a Stewards' Inquiry there was no change. GIANT HIT chased the early pace from the inside but had nothing left. GOLD ROLICK forced the early pace and tired. YUKON BANDIT was knocked off stride entering the first turn and no threat.
