GEAUX MARY chased the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, altered outside for the drive, responded to gain a short advantage mid stretch then just lasted. RAINDROPSAFALLING stalked the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the turn, responded when sat down for the drive but was outfinished. HANG ON HONEY broke sharp from the inside to gain a clear early margin, remained clear entering the turn, dueled with the winner through the drive but could not keep pace. SET PLANS chased the early pace from the inside, responded and finished well but too late. PEACHIE well placed from the inside, had no late response. NANNY'S GIFT could only pass tired ones. CRYSTAL FAITH was no factor. CAT LAK was no threat. T C'S STAR was outrun.
