CAJUN ROYALE dueled from between foes for the early lead, battled through the turn, remained forward for the drive, responded when asked but could not reach the winner. PANAMA CITY JOY chased the early pace from the inside, crept closer entering the turn, altered outside for the drive, responded and closed well late. DEVILISHES dueled from the inside early, remained engaged through the turn, battled through the drive but tired late. JODIE COPOTE chased the early pace from the inside, made a bid entering the turn and finished well. POINT LIBERTY dueled from between foes and tired. FANNING THE FLAME dueled from the outside and tired. WASHINGTON PUCK was no factor. BRESY was always outrun.
