WICKED VOW stalked the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive, gained the margin and steady drew clear under steady urging. PROLONGED dueled from the outside early, remained engaged up the backstretch, held a forward position for the drive but was no match for the winner while holding position. HIGHHOPESIDE well placed from the inside, dropped back slightly entering the second turn, responded but could only gain the show. SINISTER outrun early, advanced outside entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive and found his best stride too late. WHY SEVENTEEN went evenly. BIG ADAM dueled from the inside and tired. IDE BETTER WIN was no factor. MAY SING THE BLUES had a steady fade. BONNIE'S PROSPECT was never close.
