I'M NO PLUTO dueled from the inside early, battled through the turn, remained engaged through the drive but could not match strides. ALL THINGS GOLD up close early from the inside, held a forward position for the drive but could not keep pace. MUZHNIK chased the early pace from the outside, remained forward for the drive but could not keep pace. PROMISSORY DANCE forced the early pace from outside but had nothing left. CHOUDRANT was no factor. STORM SNOW was no threat. MEB was no menace. SHARIR was outrun.
