CHIEF JAY pressed the pace, saved ground and drove clear late. THAT'S GRAND raced within striking distance, made a late bid, proved no match for the winner, but was a clear second. BROOKS 'N DOWN raced in the back of the pack in the early part, steadied slightly entering the turn, getting in tight quarters and made an inside gain. CAJUN TRIBUTE raced within contention and finished evenly. CHATTING BANDIT pressed the pace and faded. MR BUBBA lacked early speed and was never a factor. GENEROUS MAN void of early speed and showed little. PANCHO'S SILVER duelled for the early lead and dropped back. LEONA'S SWEETBOY raced near the middle of the field and retreated.
