IMA CHU CHU TRAIN outrun early, advanced inside up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, made a bid entering the drive along the rail and was well clear late under steady urging. STORM PENNANT stalked the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the turn, responded but was no match for the winner. RETIEF broke well from the outside to set the early pace, remained forward entering the drive but could not keep pace. RUN BRICK RUN chased the early pace from the inside, remained forward entering the drive but had nothing left. COLLEGE FUND could only improve position. WAR VETERAN forced the pace from the inside and tired. AUSTIN'S BUDDY chased the pace from the inside and tired. BURNING THE RULES was no factor. ACE AND THE QUEEN showed little. SPROUTED GOLD was never close.
