SAN PACIFICCO dueled from the inside early, gained a clear margin up the backstretch, widen the effort entering the second turn, held a clear margin at the eighth pole and was well clear late while never asked. CLUB outrun early, advanced inside up the backstretch, altered outside entering the second turn, responded but could only gain the place. DIABLO ACT stalked the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, responded but could not keep pace. LORD AUBREY forced the early pace outside but had nothing left. BEST INTENT could only improve position. ALWAYS LIVELY went evenly. CACTUS MAX pressed the early pace and tired. SILENT VENDETTA was no factor. CHICOLA up close early from the outside, gave way.
