RECKON vied for the lead, saved ground around the final turn, drove clear, was all out and held on for the win. SAKAKAWEA unhurried in the early part, moved up, four wide around the final turn, made a bid and was outfinished for the win. OPPORTUNITY LOST raced near the back in the early going, came around both turns five wide, rallied down the lane and was outfinished by the top two. BABETT raced within contention, came around the final turn three wide, made a bid and hung. HOLD THE SUGAR lacked early speed, saved ground around the final turn, moved up, but was no factor. LIL' ELLIE dueled for the early lead and faded. BROKEN LINK vied for the early lead and retreated. LOOK OF SUCCESS void of early speed and was never close.
