COMEON HAYNESVILLE was away alertly and quickly set the pace, was nicely rated on the front end, led throughout and lasted late under strong handling. CARSON'S HONOR stalked the pace, rallied in the stretch, finished with courage and was gaining. LE SEUR never far back, rallied through the stretch on the inside and finished willingly. MAURICEVILLE was wide in the first turn, well placed down the backside, lacked a kick and went evenly late. DYNAMIC TIME was five wide on the first turn, lost ground throughout, had no rally. COREY'S RED BOY well placed early, faltered after a half. MAY SING THE BLUES broke in air, rallied on the second turn five wide then flattened out. EAGLE FALLS was wide in the first turn and tired. THE STEWARDS POSTED THE INQUIRY SIGN REGARDING THE START BUT TOOK NO ACTION.
