MANKATO STRIKE was well placed early, slipped through on the rail and dueled on the lead, prevailed through a long stretch battle, gamely. HAZARDS OF LOVE stalked the pace three wide, rallied in the stretch and gained a slight lead, fought gamely but was outfinished. MY BELL BOY well placed early, angled in at the top of the stretch, then went evenly. TRUE COURSE allowed to settle, had a mild bid while no threat. LA PIANO MAN dueled while between horses, tired in the stretch. MAX THE KNIFE slow early, was no threat. LOUISIANA DE SOTO well placed early, dropped back on the second turn. LORENZO flashed early speed, then stopped.
