## Footnotes

RALLY CRY settled back from crowding early, weaved in and out through traffic to advance through the turn, split rivals going to the sixteenth pole, was all out and got up in time. PARTYBAG dueled for the early lead inside, moved outside SPEEDY TEST on the turn, took over into the stretch, was briefly clear going to the sixteenth pole, drifted out late and had to settle for second best. SPEEDY TEST vied for the early lead just outside PARTYBAG, took over and gained the rail into the turn, was caught leaving the turn, dueled to the sixteenth pole and flattened out. PRINCE ANTE was void of early speed, made a mild bid between rivals to gain a striking position but leveled off through the deep stretch. SPEED N THRU broke alertly, dueled for the early lead between rivals but gave way five wide the last quarter mile. BAG ME UP was never a factor and only passed between beaten ones the last quarter. NEALVILLE showed brief speed outside but began to give way on the turn. READY AND ABEL angled out early to lost ground six to eight wide on the turn and lacked a response in the lane. LAST RULER raced in contention between rivals early, angled to the rail on the turn but faltered in the drive. FEMME DE FRASER showed little in an outside trip.
