CURLEY'S ISSUE broke well from the outside, dueled for the early margin, came inside when clear up the backstretch, held a forward position entering the drive, battled with OLIVIA'S BELLE through the drive and inched clear of that one late. OLIVIA'S BELLE up close early from the inside, altered outside up the backstretch, responded entering the second turn, dueled with the winner but could not match strides. TIPPY DUGAS chased the early pace from the outside, held a forward position entering the second turn but could not keep pace. LADY CAYLEE chased the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, responded but was too late. LINDSEY'S TIME forced the early pace from the inside but had nothing left. TIKASOUP went evenly. MISSION TO COLLECT was no real factor. KISS FOR ANNIE LEE was never close. MITY NICE STAR dueled from the inside early and gave way.
