MIRROR BAY bobbled at the start, was outrun early, inched closer entering the second turn, circled rivals through the second turn, responded to pressure and was along in time. LOUISIANA LIGHT stalked the early pace from the outside, gained a clear margin entering the second turn, remained well clear at the eighth pole but could not last. ANGEL DIVINE chased the early pace from the inside, altered outside entering the second turn, made bid but could not sustain the effort. SUDDEN GALE chased the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the second turn and finished well. SHEZA TENPINS dueled from the inside early, remained engaged up the backstretch then tired in the drive. ANGEL FISH was no factor. ZEALUNAR chased the early pace inside but had nothing left for the drive. SET PLANS dueled from the outside and tired.
