### Footnotes

CHANGE OF ORDERS broke sharp from the outside, gained a clear early margin, widen the effort up the backstretch, remained clear entering the second turn, responded when challenged entering the drive and had something left for the drive to be clear. SPEIGHTER MAN outrun early, steadily advanced outside, reached a striking position entering the second turn, challenged the winner entering the drive but could not keep pace. SKIPBERRY WINE chased the early pace from the inside, held a forward position through the second turn but was no match late. SCOTCHN WATER forced the early pace from the outside but had nothing left. DROOLIN JO JO was no real factor. DOUBLE TALK forced the early pace from the inside and tired. DAVY'S RUNNER was finished early, pulled up in the backstretch and walked off.
