SILENT PLEASURE stalked the leaders in the early going, moved up around the final turn and was going away at the end. DREAMSANDVISIONS raced within striking distance, moved up on the inside around the final turn, proved no match for the winner, but was a clear second. MIDDLEWEIGHT lacked early speed, made a late bid, but was no match for the top two. KEY WEST BREEZE unhurried in the beginning, made a mild bid, but was no factor. WALK IN THE SNOW void of early speed and was never a factor. HIGH STRIKE ZONE duelled for the early lead, drove clear, then faltered. OCEAN RIPPLE challenged for the early lead and was pulled up around the final turn.
