Footnotes

C THRU TEDDY, wearing a nasal strip, angled in while taking command soon after the break, held sway to the end under steady pressure. EXCLUSIVE EMOTION, away sharply, chased inside the pacesetter to the turn, angled outside that rival in the furlong grounds but proved second best. JAMIE'S BEAUTY, under urging to gain contention along the inside, saved ground through the turn while never getting on terms with the top two. MME. SOLEIL broke inwards, bumping DEAL TO BOAST while prominent between foes early, weakened racing midway through the turn. B B'S LUCKY GIRL, checked when bumped at the start by CHARGER'S BEAUTY, lost position, angled six wide on the backstretch, continued in that path through the turn to pass tiring rivals late. BLAZING SUNNY angled in when soon outpaced, saved ground to the stretch while never mounting a serious challenge. GARDE SOLIEL was soon outpaced racing along the inside. DEAL TO BOAST, bumped at the start by MME. SOLEIL, recovered to track the pace along the inside but came up empty when called upon. CHARGERS BEAUTY advanced briefly outside rivals to challenge, but soon gave way racing into the turn. MISTY SPECTRE was caught five wide early and soon faded.
