VICTORY FOR D J raced in the middle of the field, came around the final turn three wide, rallied down the stretch and got up in time. KRISTINA'S DAY went to the front, drove clear and was caught at the wire. QUEEN TEEN lacked early speed, moved up on the inside around the second turn, checked, getting in tight quarters on the rail, then made a late bid. ALI'S MISS LEADER challenged for the early lead, saved ground, then weakened. CRY'S SASSY LADY void of early speed, raced five wide around the final turn, then showed late interest. RUN DANCER RUN lacked early speed, raced four wide around the first turn, moved up on the inside, but was no factor. VITESSE DE FUSIL pressed the early pace, raced five wide around the first turn and faded. RUNNING MISTRESS challenged for the early lead, then dropped back. SLADE'S BAYOU pressed the early pace, came around the first turn four wide and was done early. LEIGH GOLD raced near the middle of the field, retreated and was no threat late.
