TOP CAT BOOGIE stalked the pace three wide, rallied in the upper stretch, finished gamely through a long drive and edged clear at the wire. COURTESY CAT dueled early, gained a clear lead at the top of the stretch, held gamely through a long battle and just missed. HURRICANE BLUFF well placed early, angled out four wide and finished willingly to be best of the rest. PORTO POTTEA allowed to settle early, had a mild rally while no threat. BUCKTOWN raced in the middle of the pack, lacked a late bid and went evenly. CONFLICT COMMANDER dueled early, chased the speed, came up empty in the stretch. TEN BEARS allowed to settle, failed to contend. WHOS YOUR DAD broke slowly and was never a threat.
