CHANGING STORM stalked the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive and was clear late. ROUTE outrun early, advanced inside up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, awaited room entering the drive, got through along the rail and was gaining late. ROUGHHOUSE duelled from the outside early, gained a clear margin entering the second turn, remained clear at the eighth pole but could not last. CLEVER DANZIG unhurried early, advanced inside entering the second turn and finished well. MR. DIRECTIONAL pressed the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the second turn but flattened out in the drive. QUICK SCORE forced the early pace from between foes but had nothing left for the drive. CHOCOLATE SOLDIER was no factor. DOLLAR FACTOR chased the early pace and tired. EARTHQUAKE was no factor. BANGO duelled from the inside and gave way.
