G. MONEY up close early from the inside, inched closer entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive, gained a clear margin at the eighth pole then was all out to last. JULIE'S WARRIOR stalked the early pace from the inside, remained forward entering the second turn, responded and was gaining late. BOWLING broke sharp from the outside to gain a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, held a forward position entering the drive but could not keep pace. TRICK CREDIT well placed from the inside, remained forward for the drive but could not match strides. ZIEGFELD chased the early pace outside but had nothing left. GOOD FLAMIN FRYDIE could only improve position. NORTHERN DELI was no factor. COLD EAST WIND was no threat. TURN AND REPENT had little interest. HICKMAN GOLD had a steady fade.
