BURKE'S BOOK well placed from the inside early, steadily advanced up the backstretch, remained along the rail entering the second turn, gained a clear margin at the eighth pole and proved best while kept to task. STEWY stalked the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive but could not reach the winner. FASHION SEA unhurried early from the inside, steadily advanced up the backstretch, responded but could not keep pace. BAYOU VERMILION pressed the early pace outside, held a forward position for the drive but was no threat late. MARKET CHARGER dueled from the inside and tired. SIR VALIDATOR dueled from the outside and tired. MANDATED RULER was no factor. PRIZED PAL was no threat. SOVEREIGN DAY was wide up the backstretch and had little interest. A P CASTELLI had a steady fade.
