INTERCOMPANY LOAN dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, shook loose entering the drive, opened a clear margin and was clear late while in hand the final furlong. SUSPECT SARA dueled from the outside early, remained engaged with the winner up the backstretch, dropped back slightly entering the drive, responded to come again but was no match for the winner. ISABEL EXPRESS stalked the early pace from the inside, steadily advanced entering the second turn, made a bid but flattened out in the drive. THE FAT LADY SINGS unhurried from the inside, altered outside entering the drive, responded and closed well late. AUTOBEPAMPHERED allowed to settle, advanced outside entering the second turn, responded but could not sustain the effort. LOUISIANA MAGIC went evenly. CARENCRO was no factor. OLIVIA'S MAGICSTAR chased the early pace and tired. GALE forced the early pace and gave way.
