SANGRIA WINE was forwardly placed then angled out at the head of the stretch and closed willingly to draw clear. ARCTIC CHARM was rushed to the lead while racing two wide and tired late. LILY RHETT was allowed to settle from the inside and rallied for the show. TALLEY ME UP stalked the pace and gave an even effort. KITTY TWO dueled for the lead and lacked the late response needed. KEEN RALLY trailed the field early while racing wide throughout and improved position. NOMA raced in the middle of the pace and was outrun. PANOLA TIME was off a bit slow and was not a factor. EASTER PASSAGE drifted out first turn and was not a threat. SWEET LITTLE LILLY failed to menace.
