KELAMON stalked the pace, rallied in the upper stretch, prevailed after a long drive under strong handling. THEIRBANKINGONME set the early pace, duelled on the lead, gave way grudgingly late and held place. BON TON ROULET duelled early four wide, early dropped back slightly on the turn, came again three wide in the stretch and was gaining. ZAN'S LAKE MORGAN well placed and saved ground, went evenly. KAYOSIDY raced mid pack, lacked a late kick and went evenly. ROARING DOWN SOUTH duelled early while between horses, tired. HURRICANE LOUIS had brief early speed and gave way. CHELSEA DIABLO was never a threat. CUCOS GONE TO RENO was outrun.
