COSTA PRETTY PENNY raced in the middle of the pack, came around the first turn on the outside, made a late bid, proved no match for the winner, but got up for the place. CARLY CASTELLI void of early speed, gained ground late and just missed the place position. STAR CHARGER pressed the early pace, forwardly placed throughout and hung late. OUR MISS HUFF challenged for the early lead, saved ground around the final turn and faded. RAISER'N CLASS raced in the middle of the field and lacked a late bid. TUNE A WIN FOR A B lacked early speed, raced outside around both turns and was no factor. BENJAMIN'S FOXY raced near the middle of the field, then retreated. LADY VAMP always raced near the back and showed little. CORT SPORT vied for the early lead, drove clear, then retreated to the rear.
