RICHMAR drifted in at the start, began to duel for the lead with BIG ADAM, took command at the top of the stretch and drew clear in the stretch. After viewing replays stewards disqualified RICHMAR from first to fourth for interference at start. BIG ADAM duelled for the lead with RICHMAR, raced along the inside in the far turn and could not keep up the pace in the stretch. DOWN THE ROAD steadied at the start, began to advanced position heading into the turn and gained ground in the drive. TOOLENGTHSOFLITE steadied at the start, stalked the front runners and came up empty in the stretch. WISH YOU GOLD stalked runners early and lacked a late response. WIREMEALILCHECK failed to threaten. LEE CITY SLEW chased the early pace and weakened.
