TRAIN HEIST set the pace and was well handled on the front, was challenged in the stretch, prevailed after a long battle under firm handling. CHITCHATATTHETRACK stalked the pace, rallied at the quarter pole, finished with courage but could not get past the winner. SKY BLUE MONGOLIA well placed and saved ground, went evenly late. SOMOVILLE pressed the pace, weakened in the stretch. COTEAU CAT allowed to settle, failed to menace. AFTERMEYOUREFIRST unhurried early, was never a threat. PORTO POTTEA well placed for three quarters, gave way in the stretch. COPPERVALE well placed early, dropped back on the second turn. HULA PIE wide early, was outrun.
