Footnotes

DORSEY'S DREAM settled behind the early front runners, steadily began to advance position heading into the turn, slipped thru between rivals in the upper stretch and dug in late to prevail. SIERRA MAESTRA raced in the back of the pack early, saved ground along the rail, raced behind rivals in a crowded upper stretch, angled out mid stretch and finished strongly on the outside. SOUTHERN VALUES took command early, continued to lead the way, began to feel pressure at the top of the stretch and was unable to match strides late. DR. GRAUSTARK raced up close early, raced three wide in the turn and came up empty in the drive. TENURE stalked the early front runners, raced three wide in the turn and made a mild bid in the stretch. BEST CHANCE raced six wide in the turn and finished evenly in the stretch. TRAIT raced five wide in the turn and failed to rally late. CHANGE OF ORDERS raced near the inside and steadily weakened. BACK IN FASHION saved ground along the inside and was never a factor. CLASSIC LIL HOOVES made a bid in the early going and faded after a half.
