RAIL RIDGE vied for lead with SOUTHERN VINTAGE and CUSH through the three sixteenths pole, gained command at the quarter, drew off in the early stretch. STONEY GOLD raced at the back of the pack in the fifth position, offered a late gain in the stretch. JOHN CHARLES raced even throughout, offered a late gain in the stretch. SOUTHERN VINTAGE vied for lead with RAIL RIDGE and CUSH through the three sixteenths pole, chased the pace in to the stretch, faded. RANGER DANGER gave a dull effort. KISSIN CHILD passed tiring rival CUSH, was outrun. CUSH vied for lead with RAIL RIDGE and SOUTHERN VINTAGE through the three sixteenths pole, showed brief speed and dropped back.
