ROCKIN NUEL up close early from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, responded along the rail and was along in time. PAINTED WARRIOR dueled from the outside early, gained a clear margin entering the turn, remained clear at the eighth pole but could not last. ALLIE'S MR. BOB pressed the early pace from the outside, responded entering the drive but could only gain the show. BANK THIEF forced the early pace from the inside but had nothing left for the drive. ADAMO could only pass tired ones. SOUTHERN MISTER went evenly. BLUSHING TOUGH forced the early pace and tired. ALEC'S DIMPLE was no factor. TOUGH MARCO showed little.
