THE DIVINE TUNNEL broke sharp from the outside, gained a clear early margin, dueled up the backstretch, remained engaged through the second turn, battled through the drive and inched clear late. IT'S NO SECRET up close early from the inside, crept closer entering the second turn, dueled with the winner through the drive but could not match strides. ITS CHAMPAGNE TIME forced the early pace from between foes, held a forward position through the second turn but could but just last for the show. NIMBLE TIGER chased the early pace from the inside, responded entering the drive but was outfinished for the show. SEVEN MILE BRIDGE could only pass tired ones. JULIE'S RED BANDIT pressed the early pace from the inside but had no late response. FIRST COMMAND was no factor. MARGOS WALKER forced the early pace and tired. LEESTOWN GIFT was no threat. EVEN had little interest.
