HOT FOOT HEAT dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, shook loose at the eighth pole and proved much the best while in hand the final furlong. DILLON'S GOLD IDEA stalked the early pace from the inside, steadily advanced entering the turn, responded along the rail but could only gain the place. PRINCE GO GO chased the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, altered outside for the drive but could only gain the show. FRANS LUCKY ONE dueled from the outside for the early lead, battled through the turn with the winner, remained forward but could not keep pace. TEE GARCON chased the early pace from the outside but had no late response. GRAY NOBLE could only improve position. ETBAUER'S FINEST was no factor. TOOTHPICKSANDWATER was no threat. HAY DUDE had little interest. JAYS DEFENSIVELINE was always outrun.
