CHAOTIC KITTY stalked the pace while racing three wide then made an outside rally in the final turn and kept to task. ALYSAY raced in the middle of the pack and closed willingly from the three path to finish strong. JONNY'S JEWEL was unhurried early while racing wide throughout and closed well. TOP DOLL was off a bit slow then was hustled to the middle of the pack and lacked room in the final turn to be steadied and finished well. QUEEN NOLA was allowed to settle while racing wide and passed tiring rivals in the stretch. MY PRIVATE OPINION was forwardly placed and faded. HUE BLUE BAYOU chased the leaders and weakened. THE TWILIGHT ONE was not a factor. FOUR TIMES FOUR set the early pace and gave way. STREAMING LIVE pressed the pace through the final turn and tired.
