WAKE UP SAL unhurried early from the inside, advanced up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, responded to pressure entering the drive, split rivals and was along in time. WHY SEVENTEEN broke sharp from the inside, gained a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, held a clear advantage entering the second turn, remained clear at the eighth pole but could not last. BROTHERS NICHOLAS outrun early, advanced outside entering the second turn, responded and was just up for the show. ANGELONMYSHOULDER (GB) forced the early pace from the outside, responded but was outfinished for the show. DOMINATION forced the early pace from the outside but had nothing left for the drive. NO REGRET was no factor. ARCTIC COMET chased the early pace and tired. LATCH LIGHTING forced the pace and tired. SINISTER was never close. CHEER FOR GOLD was finished after going a half.
