FASHION GAL raced in the back of the pack in the beginning, moved up four wide around the final turn, rallied down the stretch and drove clear before the wire. FOREST JAZZY went to the front, drove clear, proved no match late for the winner, but held on for second. I'VE BEEN HUMBLLED pressed the pace, forwardly placed throughout and missed the place position. ZARB'S BALLERINA raced within contention, lacked a rally and put forth an even effort. QUEEN ROLEX pressed the pace, raced three wide around the final turn and faded. FLAMINGO KEY lacked early speed and was never a factor. BRIGHTSTARRYWALK always raced near the back, came around the first turn five wide and showed little. GAL WONDER raced in the middle of the field and retreated.
