### Footnotes

BREAK UP settled in early behind the front runners, began to advance position heading into the turn racing three wide, kicked in the stretch and rallied to be up in time, setting new track record. SNUG stalked the early pacesetters, edged up to the lead heading into the turn, took command by a slight margin and was caught in final strides. MR. PORTER stalked runners early, made a bid heading into the turn racing three wide, raced within striking distance of leader in the stretch and hung late. ITS MR SLEW TO YOU raced in the back of the pack early, hit the top of the stretch and rallied to make a mild gain late. SOUTHERN STYLE saved ground along the inside and failed to rally late. SILENT PIPE raced up close early and steadily faded. VALID STRIPES led the way early and had nothing left late.
