SHEER BEAUTY stalked the early pacesetters, began to advance position heading into the turn, raced between rivals in tight upper stretch and held clear in final strides. JOY'S PARADISE set the early pace by a slight margin, continued to be the leader until the top of the stretch, was challenged by SHEER BEAUTY in mid stretch and was unable to hold on. JILL MARIE raced in the back of the pack early, steadily advanced position along the inside in the stretch and was up in time for show. LOCAL settled in behind the early pacesetters, began to advance position heading into the turn, raced three wide and had a mild gain in the stretch. ANYTHING BUT QUIET raced up close behind the top two pacesetters, raced within striking distance of leader at the top of the stretch but could not sustain bid late. PRETTY NOT made a brief bid, raced four wide in the turn and failed to threaten late. SOUTHERN YANKEE raced up close and vied for the lead, was forced to check sharply and had nothing left. VERA BELLE raced three wide in the turn and was no threat late.
