SUCCESSFUL STORY stalked the early pace from the outside, crept closer entering the turn, dueled through the drive with FAST KEYNER and inched clear of that one late. FAST KEYNER up close early from the outside, gained a clear margin entering the turn, dueled through the drive with the winner but could not match strides. SATELLITE SOPO pressed the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the stretch and closed well late. CANDY ROLL chased the early pace from the outside but had nothing left. SUNDAY'S SUN could only pass tired ones. PEACE AT LAST was no factor. AUTUMN TRIP was no threat. RUDESILL chased the early pace and tired. JAMES GANG showed little. MINISTER OF GOLD broke sharp from the inside, gained a clear early margin, blew the turn and was eased to the finish.
