CHIEF TED dueled from between foes for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, battled through the drive with TYME FOR WILLARD and inched clear of that one late. TYME FOR WILLARD dueled from the inside early, battled through the turn, remained engaged with the winner through the drive but could not match strides. RICHMAR forced the early pace from the outside, remained forward but could not keep pace. STORM SNOW chased the early pace from the outside, remained forward but was outfinished for the show. BROADWAY KING chased the early pace from the inside but could only improve position. CUTTHECANDY forced the early pace and tired. HUFFS MR. BIGGS was no factor. LOTHARIO was no threat. MUSIC STREET was never close. BLUE TRIBUTE chased the early pace from the outside, faded entering the drive, ducked in hitting the rail, lost rider, bled and was vanned off.
