SCREAMING stalked the early pace from the inside, steadily advanced entering the turn, responded entering the drive, angled off the rail mid stretch and was along in time. CHARGRAY dueled from the inside early, battled through the turn, gained a clear margin at the eighth pole but could not last. POOF SHE'S GONE chased the early pace from the inside, remained forward for the drive but could not keep pace. LEES LAST MELODY dueled from the outside early, remained engaged through the turn but had nothing left for the drive. MY COPY CAT stumbled to her knees at the start, recovered to chase the early pace, responded and finished well. DONE DONE IT could only improve position. A LITTLE BOSSIE was never close. PAWSIE'S GATE pressed the early pace and tired. SHE'S A ZINGER had a steady fade.
