ISLE BREVILLE stalked the leaders early, moved up to take command nearing the five-sixteenths pole, opened a clear margin into the lane and was fully extended to hold the closing IMPERIAL QUEEN off late. IMPERIAL QUEEN raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the second turn, responded to steady handling and was gaining on the winner with every stride. ITSJUSTBLOOD pressed the pace from between rivals and gave way in the drive. BOOK OF BUSINESS pressed the pace from the outside and gradually gave way. WILKO GAL raced off the leaders from between foes, moved outside through the second turn and failed to rally. WHAT A SIGHT was void of early speed, raced wide through the second turn and did not reach contention. I SUPPOSE SO broke awkwardly, lacked early foot, raced wide through the second turn and did not offer a bid. ELLA'S DEELITE broke inward, lagged early, raced wide through the second turn and was not a factor. DAECALLHERDASTREAK raced off the leaders from the outside and gradually weakened. SURELY GRAND broke sharply to set a pressured pace from the inside, stopped after going five furlongs, was pulled up into the lane and walked off.
